* Lawmakers did not have a full legislative session of votes in 2024. That year, Rep. Sue Chew cast votes using a substitute and Rep. Colin Nash cast a handful of votes using a substitute but was ultimately replaced by Rep. Todd Achilles once his seat was officially vacated.

NOTES:

In the House of Representatives, lawmakers were measured against Rep. Colin Nash in 2023 and Rep. Nate Roberts in 2024 as the two most liberal Democrats in the chamber. Likewise, lawmakers in the Senate were compared against Sen. Melissa Wintrow for both years. The agreement score only considers the votes that were cast when both the most liberal Democrat and the legislator being compared were both present.
